Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.107 dated 31.12.2014, under Sections 363-A, 323, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana.

Present FIR was registered on the statement of Sehzaad. Allegations were that on 31.12.2014 at about 1:00 p.m. a car stopped near his house and from which two persons have alighted and one person picked up his son Mukadar Ali, aged about one year and abducted him.

Kidnapped boy is stated to have been recovered on 01.01.2015 from co-accused Sohan Singh and Tej Kaur. During the course of investigation Sarvesh Kumar, Paramjit Singh @ Babbu were arrested on 02.01.2015.

The present petitioner is sought to be implicated on the

basis that the car in question was recovered from him as also co-accused Sarvesh Kumar.

Petitioner is in custody since 02.01.2015. It has also gone uncontroverted that co-accused Sohan Singh, Tej Kaur as also Sarvesh Kumar and Ramandeep have been granted benefit of regular bail by this Court. State counsel further apprised the Court that the trial is still at the very initial stage, the same would take time to conclude.

In view of the above, coupled with the length of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner and without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.

Disposed of.
