As per the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the State cannot be directly impleaded through the police. Therefore, the learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to file amended Memo of Parties.

Amended Memo of Parties filed in Court today, which is taken on record.

Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 26.2.2016. The certificate of marriage has been placed on record as Annexure-P-3. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure-P-4. The true typed copies of Aadhar Cards, showing the date of birth of petitioner No. 1 and petitioner No. 2, have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2 respectively.

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It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 26.2.2016 (Annexure-P-5) before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No. 2, for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents No. 5 to 7.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana-respondent No. 2, to consider the application of the petitioners dated 26.2.2016 (Annexure-P-5) and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, this order shall not be construed as a recognition of valid marriage between the parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
