ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 32 dated 22.03.2015 registered at Police Station Buria District Yamuna Nagar under Sections 363/366(A)/376D IPC and Section 5(g) of the POCSO Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations are that Irfan and Jahangir (petitioner) had kidnapped two daughters of the complainant. He further contends that they had got married and the prosecutrix had admitted her signatures on the Nikahnama but before the Court she states that her signatures were forcibly taken and the prosecutrix has been examined and both the girls have got married and the trial is taking time. The petitioner is in custody for over 11 months. He

further urges that co-accused Irfan had already been granted bail by this Court.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
