TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA. J (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.07 dated 16.01.2011, under Sections 379/411/420/482 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nakodar, District Jalandhar.

Allegations in a nutshell against the petitioner are that he is the member of a gang who steal vehicles and thereafter sell the same by affixing false and fake number plates.

During the course of arguments, it has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner having been arrested was granted benefit of bail. However, he absented from the trial proceedings on 20.03.2014 and was subsequently declared a proclaimed offender on 02.09.2015.

Be that as it may, petitioner was arrested on 17.12.2015.

It is also the conceded position of fact that co-accused in the present FIR have been granted benefit of bail.

Petitioner having been arrested has faced incarceration since 17.12.2015.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
