Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case of recovery of 33 bottles of Rexcof weighing 100 ml each from co-accused Darshan Ram. Petitioner was involved in the case on the basis of disclosure statement of Darshan Ram disclosing that he had purchased the bottles from the petitioner for a sum of Rs.3300/-. Petitioner appears to have been charged under Section 27-A of the NDPS Act. It will certainly be a debatable issue if the petitioner has committed any offence under Section 27-A of the NDPS Act.

In view of above said circumstances and without expression of any opinion on merits of the case or the propriety of the charge framed against the petitioner, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail he being in custody with effect from 31.01.2016.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that petitioner will not indulge in the similar activity of supply or possession of narcotic or psychotropic

substance during the pendency of the trial. In case of any such
eventuality, this bail order will be liable to be cancelled.
