Vide this common order above mentioned two revisions are
being disposed of.

The petitioner has challenged the order of the Appellate Court
whereby even though the conviction was maintained but the private

respondents were order to be released on probation.

After arguing for some time, the matter has been settled. The private respondents would pay compensation of Rs.5000/- each to the petitioner within one month. The petition is consequently disposed of in the above terms. For this purpose, parties are directed to appear before the Trial Court on 21.12.2016 when the money will be disbursed to the complainant.

Needless to say that if the amount is not disbursed to the complainant the present petitions would be deemed to be dismissed and private respondent liable to be arrested to serve out their sentence.

Revision petitions stand disposed of.
