JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 read with Section 483 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") by Gurmail Singh-petitioner seeking issuance of directions to Id. trial court to decide the criminal complaint No. 277, dated 04.12.2010 (Annexure P-1) captioned as "***Gurmail Singh vs. Yashwinder Kumar Sharma***", expeditiously.

2. It has been *inter alia* contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that though preliminary evidence was closed by the Id. trial court on August 19, 2013 but till date, no order either under Section 203 or 204 Cr.P.C. has been passed.

3. This Court has also perused various interim order(s) passed by the court(s) below, which is suggestive of the fact that no serious

action has been taken by the Id. Magistrate(s) and the complaint is being adjourned time and again either at the request of the complainant or his counsel. Now, the matter is stated to be fixed for March 30, 2016 for consideration before the Court concerned.

4. Thus, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the Id. Magistrate/trial court to take the matter seriously and pass an appropriate order on the basis of the evidence available on file before 10.04.2016.
