The petitioner, an agent working in Tehsil complex at Sangrur, is alleged to have prepared fake documents for seeking transfer of vehicles. In the present case the petitioner is alleged to have, on refusal of D.T.O Sangrur to allot registration number of Punjab to the vehicles, manipulated the record with fake seals and forged signatures of D.T.O Sangrur to get the vehicles transferred.

The petitioner is in custody with effect from 06.01.2016. His co-accused Bhushan Pal has been granted concession of bail. Without expression of any information on merits, it is sufficient to observe that the petitioner had been granted concession of interim temporary bail for two days in order to enable him to attend the marriage of his cousin. He has not misused his liberty and has already surrendered. Since the investigation is almost complete and the petitioner has been in custody for almost 90 days, he can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Mansa.
