JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J. (Oral)

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.04, dated 11.01.2016, registered under Sections 452, 323, 324 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of the order dated 31.03.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the

investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 31.03.2016, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
