Petitioners have filed the present petition for issuance of direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their lives and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

In compliance of order dated 01.3.2016, learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record a photocopy of the FDR for an amount of Rs.1,00,000/- in the name of petitioner No.1-Gurpreet. Same is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the

statement and copies of affidavits of petitioners to the effect that the petitioners do not have any threat to their lives and liberty and they do not need any protection. Copies of statement and affidavits of petitioners are taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of this position, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

However, in case the petitioners still feel any danger to their lives, they are at liberty to approach respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar.
