Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, Amritsar to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representations dated November 16, 2015 (Annexure P-3) and February 11, 2016 (Annexure P-4) and if the allegations levelled in the said representations are *prima-facie* established, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
