JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 4 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.5 to 11 and further not to interfere in their married life.

2. Notice to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.
3. At the asking of Court, Mr. Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioners to prefer a detailed representation to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police,

Kaithal, Distt. Kaithal unfolding all the facts and circumstances on the basis of which they require protection within a period of 7days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and on receipt thereof, the matter shall be enquired into and dealt with by respondent No.2 deeply and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action with regard to providing of security etc to the petitioners, in accordance with law.

5. However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
