Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners. Even on the last date of hearing i.e. 30.03.2016, no one appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has produced statement of petitioner No.1-Baljit Kaur who states that she had solemnized marriage with Mandeep Singh-petitioner No.2 against the wishes of her parents and relatives, who at that time were not happy with said marriage but now she does not apprehend any danger/threat at the hands of private respondents and does not need any security/protection. Learned State counsel has also produced affidavits of respondents No.5 and 9 stating therein that they have

no objection to the marriage of the petitioners. The said affidavits of respondents No.5 and 9 and statement of petitioner No.1 are taken on record.

In view of above, the present petition no more survives and is accordingly dismissed.
