In pursuance to the order passed by this Court on 2.3.2016, the report has been received from the learned District and Sessions Judge, Ambala, which shows that a team, consisting of Deputy Commissioner, Ambala, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Crime Branch, Ambala, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Ambala Cantt. and District and Sessions Judge, Ambala, raided the premises of District Jail, Ambala. From Barrack No. 32, a substance of black coloured, wrapped in a small piece of paper, was found, which has been sent for analysis and it is expected that if it is found to be covered under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, necessary action will be taken. From one inmate, one mobile phone and Rs. 2,000/- were recovered; from another inmate, one sim was

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recovered and from third inmate, Rs. 5,000/- were recovered, regarding which cases have been registered. It is reported that the allegations levelled by the petitioner regarding sale of intoxicant drugs, heroin and smack in jail premises could not be substantiated.

It being so, the present petition is disposed of.
