Prayer is under Section 439 Cr.PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner-Bhupinder @ Happy in case FIR No.306 dated 06.10.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code and Section 201 of Indian Penal Code added later on registered with Police Station Ambala City.

On the complaint of the court of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge, Ambala the aforesaid FIR was lodged.

The petitioner-accused is alleged to have impersonated as Harbans Singh and provided surety to one Ranjit at the time of securing bail in a separate FIR. The co-accused Labh Singh is the one who is alleged to be involved in racket of arranging such sureties.

It is contended that the petitioner is in custody since 8.10.2015 and after completion of investigation challan stands presented and 05 out of 14 cited prosecution witnesses stands examined. It is next submitted that the main accused Labh Singh has already been enlarged on bail.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Mukesh does not dispute the custody period and the stage of trial and that co-accused has been enlarged on bail.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period, parity of treatment and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, present petition is allowed and the petitioner Bhupinder Singh @ Happy is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate, Ambala.

Petition stands disposed of.
