Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.49 dated 17.05.2015, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Bahaw Wala, District Fazilka.

As per prosecution version, the alleged recovery from the petitioner is of 50 bottles of rexcof and 3 kgs. of intoxicant powder and which upon receipt of Chemical Examiner report has found to be containing salt of Alprazolam, Codeine Phosphate and Chlorpheniramine Maleate.

The alleged recovery effected from the petitioner is commercial in nature.

Under such circumstances, prayer of the petitioner seeking benefit of regular bail is declined.

Petition stands dismissed.
