DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for conducting free and fair investigation in case FIR No.142 dated 12.08.2015 registered under Sections 452/336/354/506/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27/54 of the Arms Act at Police Sation Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the case because of civil litigation, which is pending. Even a contempt petition is also pending against the police officials, who are interfering in the investigation. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner apprehends that there cannot be a fair investigation as the Investigating Officer is of the same Police Station. The petitioner has made a representation dated 14.08.2015 and the same has not been decided so far. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner

would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to decide the representation, which is still pending.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural) to consider the representation dated 14.08.2015 (Annexure P-3) and take necessary action thereupon in accordance with law after giving proper opportunity to all the parties concerned.
