RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (Oral)

Present writ petition is directed against the order dated 16.1.2007 (Annexure P-6) passed by the Financial Commissioner, Haryana, whereby ROR No.237 of 2005-06 filed by Kamal Singh-respondent No.5 herein against the petitioner-Ved Singh was allowed in a matter pertaining to mutation between the parties.

Learned counsel for respondent No.5, at the very outset, fairly submits that since during the pendency of the instant writ petition, parties have amicably settled the matter by way of a detailed compromise dated 26.10.2012 in the Civil Suit No.172 (Ved Singh Vs. Kamal Singh and others) before the learned Civil Court at Gurgaon and in view of para 5 (f) of the compromise, petitioner has undertaken to withdraw the present writ petition, it has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of, as such. He also refers to the statement suffered by the petitioner on 26.10.2012 before the learned Civil Court at Gurgaon, on the basis of above-said compromise.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner also fairly states that let the instant writ petition be dismissed as withdrawn, in view of the statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.5
