This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 6 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.7 to 12.

2. Notice to respondents No.1 to 6 only at this stage.

3. At the asking of Court, Mr. A.S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

4. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, Distt. Gurdaspur to enquire

into the allegations levelled in the representation dated February 25, 2016 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

5. However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
