Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Manjeet in case FIR No.828 dated 28.12.2015 under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered with Police Station Sadar, Fatehabad.

As per SI Tarsem Singh-complainant, co-accused Jaswant Singh @ Santu was apprehended with six kilograms of poppy husk and on his disclosure statement it surfaced that he had purchased the same from the present accused.

It is submitted that the petitioner has been falsely roped in and there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner. It is further submitted that the said disclosure statement is inadmissible in evidence

against the petitioner. That apart, even the alleged recovery is non-commercial in nature.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated in the same.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Puran Chand submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is not involved in any other criminal case as also the quantity involved is non commercial and as such is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 03rd of March, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
