FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 19.03.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Moga has been received, whereby, it is informed that statements of petitioner No.1-Lovepreet Singh as well as of complainant Kulwant Singh, Satnam Singh and Surinderpal Singh have been recorded whereas the other petitioners-accused did not turn up to make their statements and that the matter stands compromised between petitioner No.1 and the complainants voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is case of version and cross-version in which the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab**

and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052, FIR No.186 dated 27.11.2015 under Sections 323,324,506,34 IPC Police Station, Dharamkot, District Moga and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner No.1-Lovepreet Singh only.

Petition stands disposed off.
