JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Farukh in case FIR No.86 dated 13.02.2016, under Sections 120-B of the Indian Penal Code; Section 13(2) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausmvardhan Act, 2015 & Section 11 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960, registered with Police Station Nuh, District Mewat.

On secret information that petitioner-accused Farukh along with one other person is involved in cow slaughtering and on 13.02.2016 is in the process of taking cows in a canter bearing registration no.HR-55-T- 5099, was sought to be intercepted. When the canter tried to flee, it was got stopped by laying down strips of nails. Two accused fled away and there was a recovery of twenty weak and feeble cows and three calves found lodged in the apprehended truck.

It was contended that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the aforesaid case. It is highly unbelievable that he could flee from the spot. It was further stated that the petitioner is neither owner of the canter nor is involved in any other case.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Kamal Singh, concedes the aforesaid submission.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 03.03.2016, is made absolute.
