Petitioner seeks the concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Jeet Singh alleging that on February 17, 2015, the complainant and his cousin Nirmal Singh while on their way back to their house from fields, were intercepted by occupants of two cars who were armed with rifles, guns and swords, have opened fire at the complainant but the complainant escaped by going inside his house and closing the iron gate.

So far as petitioner is concerned, he was allegedly present on the spot with 315 bore rifle and fired at complainant but the said shot allegedly hit the iron gate.

Since it is a case of no injury; petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. July 30, 2015 and challan having already been presented, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to conditions that he will not threaten the witnesses or tamper with the evidence in any manner.
