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**JASPAL SINGH, J.**

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 147, dated October 14, 2011, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station City Batala, Police District Batala, Gurdaspur (**Annexure P-1**) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise (**Annexure P-2**).

2. In compliance of order dated March 04, 2016, statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court. Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Batala, has been

received, in which, it has been categorically observed that the matter has been compromised between the parties with the intervention of respectable persons, with their own free will, consent, voluntarily or without any pressure from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 147, dated October 14, 2011, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, registered at Police Station City Batala, Police District Batala, Gurdaspur (**Annexure P-1**) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
