This order will dispose of two petitions for regular bail one filed by Kuldeep Singh and another (CRM-M-7747-2016) and the other filed by Devender Singh and others (CRM-M-11413-2016) in the common FIR.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Baljeet Singh alleging that on 05.11.2015 when the complainant along with Lal Singh and seven other persons was going towards his fields for irrigation, on the tractor of Lal Singh, they were attacked by Devender Singh, Bhola Singh and Kashmir Singh, the petitioners and others.

So far as petitioner Devender Singh is concerned, he is attributed a gandasi blow on the head of Lal Singh. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition on behalf of Devender Singh at this stage. The application for bail (CRM-M-11413-2016) *qua* Devender Singh is dismissed as withdrawn.

So far as the other petitioners are concerned, Prem Singh has been attributed injury through gandasi blow from the reverse side on the person of Avtar Singh resulting in simple injury. Surinder Singh has not been attributed any specific injury. He allegedly damaged the vehicles. Virender Singh has also not been attributed specific injury. So far as Kuldeep Singh is concerned, he is attributed injuries on the person of Surjit Singh etc. besides causing damage to the tractor and motorcycle. Gurmeet Singh is attributed a danda blow on the person of Lal Singh on the left hand.

Both the petitions are allowed but for Devender Singh on whose behalf the petition stands already dismissed as withdrawn. It is ordered that petitioners No. 2, 3 and 4 namely, Prem Singh, Surinder Singh and Virender Singh in CRM-M-11413 of 2016 and petitioners Kuldeep Singh and Gurmeet Singh in CRM-M-7747 of 2016, shall be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
