The petitioner, having been found innocent during investigation in a State case, has been summoned as an accused in a protest petition having been treated as a criminal complaint.

The petitioner having already put in appearance pursuant to interim order dated 03.03.2016, this petition deserves to be allowed as it is neither a case where custodial interrogation is required nor a case where there are chances of petitioner absconding being a lady.

The petition is allowed. Interim order dated 03.03.2016 is hereby made absolute. It is ordered that the petitioner will remain on bail against the bail bonds already furnished by her subject to the condition that no attempt will be made to tamper with the evidence.
