TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.147 dated 11.09.2015 under Sections 341/342/323/506/307/34 IPC, (Section 307 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

FIR was registered on the statement of Amritpal Singh, who is stated to have suffered injuries in an occurrence dated 10.09.2015.

It has gone uncontroverted that initially the FIR was registered under Sections 341/342/323/506/34 IPC and subsequently offence under Section 307 IPC was added.

During the course of arguments, it has been conceded that the injury suffered by Amritpal Singh on his right eye brow is attributed to co-accused Gurjant Singh, who had thrown the stone at the injured. There is no specific injury attributed to the present petitioner.

Petitioner has been in custody since 16.11.2015. Investigation is still underway.

Petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Fatehgarh Sahib.
