Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner-Javed Khan in case FIR No.410 dated 23.10.2015, under Sections 420, 406, 506, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Farakpur, District Yamunanagar.

As per the allegations, the petitioner/accused-Javed Khan had allured the complainant-Kamal Kumar Gupta for making a payment of Rs.15 lacs for inducting him as partner in his firm dealing in timber business under the name and style of J.P.Timber Ltd.

It was contended that the allegations are absolutely false since there was no partnership deed. It was further submitted that a loan for a sum of Rs. 1 lac had been obtained by the petitioner and in lieu thereof, blank pronotes and cheques were signed and issued. It was thus contended that the dispute is of civil in nature without any criminal intent.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Gyan Singh, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 11.01.2016, is made absolute.
