Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Complaint Case No.266 of 2008 dated 17.12.2008 under sections 379, 411, 117, 506, 148, 149 I.P.C.

During the course of arguments, it has been conceded that the petitioner had evaded the process of law and was declared a Proclaimed Offender. Petitioner had preferred CRM No. M-12674 of 2014 in this Court for quashing of the complaint on the ground that the other co-accused have earned acquittal. Such petition was dismissed as withdrawn. However, in the order dated 13.8.2014, passed by this Court, it was observed that in case petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court within two weeks from the date of passing of the order, he would be released on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court. Petitioner inspite of such liberty having been granted, did not appear before the Trial Court.

Conduct of the petitioner disentitles him for the benefit of concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
