JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of regular bail on behalf of accused/petitioner-Sandeep Singh alias Landa in case FIR No. 78, dated 06.11.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 399, 402, Indian Penal Code, Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act and Sections 18, 22, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S. Act, registered at Police Station Phul, District Bathinda.

On a secret information that certain named non-applicants co-accused were making preparation for committing a dacoity at an ATM/Petrol Pump, a *Naaka* was set up and the accused/petitioner-Sandeep Singh alias Landa (who was driving the Verna Car) alongwith his non-applicants/co-accused Chamkaur Singh, Manpreet Singh, Balkaran Singh and another Sandeep Singh were apprehended at the spot. From the apprehended accused/petitioner-Sandeep Singh alias Landa and co-accused/non-applicant-Chamkaur Singh, .315 bore country made pistol alongwith live cartridges and

narcotics were recovered. Verna Car, being driven by the petitioner, concededly belongs to him.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 06.11.2015.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Kanwar Singh, submits that there are two other criminal cases pending against the accused/petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
