JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The prayer is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner-Sunny Kumar in case FIR No.01 dated 08.01.2016, under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Shahpurkandi, District Pathankot.

The petitioner along with co-accused are alleged to have snatched the mobile phone from the complainant-Rajni Sharma while driving a black Pulsar motorcycle on road.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 09.01.2016 while co-accused is yet to be arrested qua whom P.O. proceedings have been initiated.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Ramesh Kumar, submits that the offence entails minimum punishment of 05 years and being a heinous offence, petitioner is not entitled to the grant of regular bail at this stage, moreso, when the co-accused is still absconding.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of regular bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
