This order will dispose of two pre-arrest bail applications one filed by Sanjeev Soni and Kamni Soni (CRM-M-798 of 2016) and other filed by Preeti Soni (CRM-M-3178-2016).

The FIR was registered at the instance of Mansi Soni alleging that complainant and her husband did not have cordial relations with the parents of the deceased. On different occasions, the complainant had been given beatings on account of which she along with the deceased started living separately. On 16.12.2015 the deceased had allegedly visited the house of his father where he was insulted and ill-treated on account of which he committed suicide.

So far as petitioners Sanjeev Soni and Kamni Soni are concerned, they are uncle and aunt of the deceased. Preeti Soni petitioner is stated to be real sister of the deceased.

Viscera report has not yet been received. There is no specific allegation against the petitioners which would bring their act or conduct within the ambit of Section 107 IPC.

Petitioners, pursuant to the interim orders have already joined the investigation. The petitioners, in the said circumstances, can be granted the concession of bail.

Both the petitions are allowed. It is ordered that the petitioners, in the event of their arrest in this case will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, subject to all the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
