3. At the asking of Court, Ms. Ashima Mor, APP, UT Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of UT Chandigarh. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned counsel for UT Chandigarh during the course of day.
4. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent

No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, UT Chandigarh, to look into the grievances of the petitioners unfolded by them in their representation dated March 01, 2016 (Annexure P-5) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

5. However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
