Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.53, dated 09.04.2015, for offence punishable under Sections 22 of NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Kulgarhi, Distt. Ferozepur.

This Court, vide order dated 10.03.2016, has granted interim bail to the petitioner, however, subject to his joining the investigation and to comply with the provisions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Head Constable-Harjinder Singh, submits that despite the abovesaid order passed by this Court, petitioner has not come forward to join investigation and the bail bonds of the petitioner was cancelled on 05.02.2016, as he has jumped the bail.

Keeping in view of the fact that petitioner has not come forward to join investigation and even he has jumped the bail, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
