Learned State counsel seeks to place on record reply by way of affidavit of Parlad Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Detective, Gurdaspur. He has referred to para 2 thereof, which reads as under:-

“That the petitioner had filed an application before the office of the District Police Office, Gurdaspur pleaded innocence in the abovesaid case. The enquiry of the said application was got conducted by Sh.Puran Chand, PPS, the then Deputy Superintendent of Police, Headquarters, Gurdaspur. That during the enquiry/investigation, the petitioner found to be innocent in the above said case vide case diary No.54 dated 21.10.2011 and further approved by SSP/Gurdaspur on date 18.10.2012. The case is under investigation. After the completion of investigation, the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C will be presented before the competent court of jurisdiction.”

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to file afresh in case any cause of action arises.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
