Vide this common order above mentioned two petitions are being disposed
of.

In FIR No.248 dated 11.10.2015 registered under Sections 324/323/34 of
IPC at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar, the petitioners are being prosecuted.

Mr. Vishal Satija, Advocate for respondent No. 2-Complainant states that
now compromise has taken place between the parties. Counsel for both the parties state
that there is cross case and in other case DDR No.29 dated 11.10.2015 registered against
the petitioners. Looking into the nature of offences under Sections 323/324/34 of IPC
and further fact that counsel for both the parties accused as well as complainant are

present and that the compromise between the parties has been arrived at in order to live in peace and harmony, permission for compounding/compromise of the offences should be granted.

In that view of the matter, FIR No.248 dated 11.10.2015 registered under Sections 324/323/34 of IPC at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom subject to payment of cost in the sum of ₹ 1,000/- each petitioner with the District Collector, Jalandhar within eight weeks.

In the other case DDR No.29 dated 11.10.2015, recorded in case FIR No.248 dated 11.10.2015 registered under Sections 324/323/34 of IPC at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar, petitioners are being prosecuted.

Compromise has taken place between the parties.

In that view of the matter, DDR No.29 dated 11.10.2015, recorded in case FIR No.248 dated 11.10.2015 registered under Sections 324/323/34 of IPC at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar is quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom subject to payment of cost in the sum of ₹ 2,000/- by each petitioner with the District Collector, Jalandhar within a period of 10 weeks, if, the cost as stated above is not deposited with the District Collector, Jalandhar, this Order shall stand automatically recalled.
