Twelve out of fifteen witnesses have been examined. Keeping in view the nature of offence, it will not be appropriate for this Court to adjudicate upon the *prima facie* culpability of the petitioner to grant him concession of bail. Expecting that trial would be concluded within a period of three months after the next date of hearing, this petition is disposed of at this stage without appreciating the material which has been produced on record.

In case the trial is not concluded within the above said period, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for grant of bail.
