This is the second petition filed by the petitioner for the grant of regular bail, the first one having been dismissed as withdrawn on 26.8.2014.

On the last date of hearing, learned State counsel had informed the Court that though the prosecution had already examined eighteen witnesses and given up four, yet ten more witnesses still remained to be examined.

After obtaining instructions from SI Kanwar Bhan, P.S. Bilaspur, learned State counsel submits that the prosecution has already examined all the witnesses except ASI Surinder Singh, who could not be examined on the last date of the trial as he was present in the High Court. Now, he has been summoned for 4.6.2016.

Once the trial of the case has reached its fag end,

prayer of the petitioner for grant of regular bail, especially when it is for the second time that he is approaching this Court, cannot be granted.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
