Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Vikas @ Kaka in case FIR No.144 dated 02.10.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 457 and 380 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot, District Pathankot.

On the intervening night of 17/18.09.2014 the present accused along with his co-accused Sagar are alleged to have committed theft in a Grocery shop of the complainant Rajinder Bhalla of articles/Desi Ghee, Refind Oil and cigarette etc., after breaking open the lock.

The name of the petitioner has surfaced on the disclosure statement of the arrested co-accused Sagar.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner, keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, it is apparent that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is necessary to complete the investigation and

as such he is not entitled to the grant of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
