Report dated 03.05.2016 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class (Duty) Jalandhar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Ashwani Gahi as well as of complainant Pawan Chawla it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

No.5. Jalandhar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
