Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-William @ Manu in case FIR No.01 dated 08.01.2016 for offences punishable under Section 379-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Shahpur Kandi, District Pathankot.

As per the allegations the accused petitioner along with his co-accused Sunny Kumar came on a Pulsar Motor Cycle and snatched the mobile phone of Smt. Rajni Sharma-complainant.

The co-accused Sunny Kumar was arrested and on his disclosure statement, the name of the petitioner was surfaced.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a juvenile and, therefore prays for grant of anticipatory bail.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner, keeping in view the nature and gravity of the allegations, no case for grant of

anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.
