Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Tejinder Singh in case FIR No.277 dated 11.10.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 420, 120-B and 506 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana Rural.

As per allegations levelled by the complainant-Gurminder Kaur a widowed lady, she was induced for making a payment of Rs.7.5 lacs by the parents of the petitioner/accused i.e. co-accused Avtar Singh and Harbinder Kaur for sending her abroad along with her children. As per role attributed to the petitioner, son of other two co-accused, he had collected a sum of Rs.1 lac from the house of the complainant.

It is contended that if at all the offence is made out against parents of the petitioner who are already in jail and the petitioner who is a minor (his DOB being 28.03.1995) and a student, has been unnecessarily dragged into put pressure on the accused.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Sukhmander Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 12th of January, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
