The petitioners seek concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Balkar Singh alleging that on 13.5.2015 complainant and his nephew were assaulted by the petitioners along with five other co-accused armed with gandasi, iron rod, datar etc. Petitioner No.1 is attributed datar blow on the head of the complainant which resulted in fracture bone. Petitioner No.2 has inflicted injury with iron rod on left elbow of Balkar Singh. Injury is not explained as grievous by medical record. Besides this it is a case of cross-version.

In view of the role attributed to the petitioners and other circumstance, petitioner No.2 can be granted the concession of bail. However, no ground is made out to grant pre-arrest bail to petitioner No.1.

Petition for pre-arrest bail qua Balwinder Singh is dismissed. However, it is allowed qua Sajjan Singh. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner No.2 Sajjan Singh, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that the petitioner Sajjan Singh will join investigation as and when required and will hamper the investigation or tamper with the prosecution evidence.
