Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered at the instance of complainant Yogesh alleging that the complainant and the petitioner had a share to the extent of 50 per cent in a company named M/s Rising Facilities Management Private Limited. Both being Directors of the company, the petitioner is alleged to have defrauded the complainant by forging his signatures and resignation letter from the Directorship and used his forged signatures for operating the bank accounts and having transferred the amount from the account of the complainant.

With the assistance of the counsel for the petitioner as well as State counsel, I have gone through the police file. It appears that the signatures of the complainant with the bank officials are genuine. The amount has been withdrawn by Shamsher Ali who was also previous Director of the company and was associated with the complainant.

In views of said circumstances, it is apparently a case of combination of civil and criminal liabilities. The petitioner having joined investigation can be granted the concession of pre-arrest bail as it does not appear to be a case of custodial interrogation.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of arresting officer subject to the conditions that the petitioner will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper investigation, in any manner.
