Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.201 dated 22.6.2004, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 469 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Patiala (Annexure P-1) on the basis of agreement/ compromise (Annexure P-2).

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jitenderpal Singh submits that the police has investigated the matter and prepared a

cancellation report.

In view of this development, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner does not press this petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.

However, in case the police fails to submit the cancellation report or cancellation report submitted, but not accepted by the Court, the petitioner would be at liberty to file fresh petition seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.
