Report dated 19.03.2016 sent by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Bir Singh @ Fauji, Bachan Pal Singh, Surinder Kaur as well as of complainants Inderjit Singh Shergil it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is pure property dispute and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.309 dated 01.08.2007 under Sections 420,467,468,471,120-B IPC Police Station, Sadar District Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising

therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
