Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of FIR No.45 dated 15.04.2014, registered at Police Station Women, Patiala, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC.

The matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and as per report dated 12.08.2016, mediation has failed.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from the investigating officer submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation. All the recoveries has since been effected from him. A draft of ₹25,000/- towards litigation expenses has been given to the complainant. At this stage, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the

case, order dated 14.03.2016 passed by this Court whereby the ad-interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
