The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 19.08.2015 for being responsible for the recovery of heavy quantity of Rexcof liquid, Alprasate, Microlit and Spasmo Proxyvon tablets from co-accused of the petitioner, Sunil Kumar. The petitioner has been involved in the case on the basis of disclosure statement made by co-accused Sunil Kumar, in custody.

Since the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f 19.08.2015 and his culpability is assumed from the disclosure statement of his co-accused made in custody, which would certainly be a debatable issue at trial, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial

Court subject to the condition that he will not indulge in similar activity of which he is accused of, during pendency of the trial. In case, the petitioner indulges in similar activity, the bail granted to the petitioner will be liable to be cancelled.
