This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.62 dated 29.5.2015 under sections 22, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S Act, registered at Police Station, Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version an alleged recovery of 80 tablets of Alprazolam was effected from the petitioner on 29.5.2015. Petitioner is in custody ever since.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Deep Singh would apprise the Court that the trial is still at the initial stage as out of the five prosecution witnesses cited one has been examined till date.

Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case under the N.D.P.S Act and even the alleged recovery is concededly non-commercial.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Mansa.

Petition disposed of.
