The petitioner seeks the concession of regular bail in a case registered on the basis of a secret information that the petitioner along with his six co-accused, while confined in jail, had been in contact with Binder Pal and he had been indulging in trade of supplying and selling heroin and other intoxicating substances in different areas through telephone. The petitioner has been involved in the case on the disclosure statement of co-accused Gurmeet Singh @ Meeta. No recovery has been effected from the petitioner. He is in custody w.e.f. 05.10.2015.

The bail application has been opposed inter alia on the ground that the petitioner is involved in five other cases.

Without expression of any opinion on the culpability of the petitioner in other criminal cases; no recovery having been effected from the petitioner in the present case, he can be granted concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
